
FINANCIAL POLICY for MEDICAL SERVICES

INSURANCE BILLING & PAYMENT PROCEDURE

We are NOT contracted with any insurance companies; therefore, we do not bill insurance for medical services on your behalf. Medical office visits are on a self-pay basis, and payment is required in full at the time of your appointment.

If you choose to submit a claim to your insurance company on your own, we will provide you with the appropriate paperwork. Bear in mind, because we are considered an out-of-network provider, reimbursement is not guaranteed, and out-of-pocket patient responsibility may vary.

If you have insurance coverage through Medicare, you are ineligible for reimbursement, and neither the patient or practitioner may submit a claim.

MEDICAL OFFICE VISIT CHARGE

An initial medical office visit is \$250; any medical office visits thereafter are \$130. Any additional medical services rendered (e.g. biopsies, cryosurgery, etc.) will incur an additional charge.

If you were scheduled for a cosmetic consultation/cosmetic treatment and you receive any medical services, the appointment also becomes a **medical office visit**, and will be charged accordingly.

Below are a few examples of medical services:

- If a prescription for medication is received for any reason
- If a biopsy, excision, or “freezing” is performed
- If you receive an order for blood work

If a biopsy or excision is performed, the specimen(s) will be sent to the pathology lab for diagnosis. We may collect your insurance information and forward it to the lab; however, Total Dermatology is a separate entity from said lab, and has no affiliation with their financial policies.
